SANCTIONS RISK RELATED TO PETROLEUM SHIPMENTS INVOLVING IRAN AND SYRIA

On 25 March 2019 the US Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) issued an Advisory alerting "persons globally to the significant US sanctions risk for parties involved in petroleum shipments to the government of Syria".

Executive Order 13582 was first issued in 2011 and prohibits US persons having any dealings related to Syrian origin petroleum or petroleum products (see Britannia <u>circular</u> dated 13 May 2016). The Advisory issued by OFAC on 25 March 2019 states that Executive Order 13582 also provides grounds for sanctions against any non-US parties who supply petroleum to Syria. The Advisory also states that the same risk applies to any non-US parties involved in transactions relating to Iran origin petroleum or petroleum products.
