

Please find below updated 'Quarantine Procedures' for Indian ports as on 17 March 2020

***W/Coast Indian Ports:**

PORTS	QUARANTINE PROCEDURES
MUNDRA	<p>All vessels arriving from any foreign port (irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 Hrs prior arrival at Port. After receipt of all the documents, the Port Health Officer (PHO) will advise berthing clearance or whether ship needs Screening on berthing. By Pre Arrival Screening the ships will be categorized to Healthy & Suspected Ships. Healthy ships will undergo routine Port Operations.</p> <p>Newly embarked crew or any crew at berth if they develop fever or respiratory symptoms, will be isolated and given PPE immediately and shall intimate Port Control and Agent to alert PHO, CMO. In PHO find COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard, vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage until further clearance from PHO.</p> <p><i>*Currently Port is not following 14 days quarantine period at Anchorage for vessels arriving from affected countries.</i></p>
KANDLA	<p>All vessels arriving from any foreign port (irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 Hrs prior arrival at Port. After receipt of all the documents, PHO will advise berthing clearance or whether ship needs Screening on berthing. By Pre Arrival Screening the ships will be categorized to Healthy & Suspected Ships. Healthy ships will undergo routine Port Operations.</p> <p>Newly embarked crew or any crew at berth if they develop fever or respiratory symptoms, will be isolated and given PPE immediately and shall intimate Port Control and Agent to alert PHO, CMO. In PHO finds COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard, vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage until further clearance from PHO.</p> <p><i>*Currently Port is not following 14 days quarantine period at Anchorage for vessels arriving from affected countries.</i></p>
SIKKA	<p>All vessels arriving from any foreign port (irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 Hrs prior arrival to Port. The declaration will be scrutinized by PHO and if all crew found to be healthy then vessel will be permitted for berthing upon PHO clearance. In case PHO finds COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard, then vessel will not be berthed until further clearance from PHO.</p> <p><i>*Transit period from Chinese ports to SIKKA is greater than 14 days - so vessels not likely to face 14 day quarantine.</i></p>
VADINAR	<p>All vessels arriving from any foreign port (Irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 Hrs prior arrival to Port. The declaration will be scrutinized by PHO and if all crew found to be healthy then vessel will be allowed for berthing Upon PHO clearance. In case PHO finds COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard then vessel will not be berthed until further clearance from PHO.</p> <p><i>*Transit period from Chinese ports to VADINAR is greater than 14 days - so vessels not likely to face 14 day quarantine.</i></p>

PIPAVAV	<p>All vessels arriving from any foreign port (irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 Hrs prior arrival to Port. The declaration will be scrutinized by PHO and if all crew found to be healthy then vessel will be allowed for berthing Upon PHO clearance. In case PHO finds COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard then vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage till further clearance from PHO.</p> <p><i>*Currently Port is not following 14 days quarantine period at anchorage; for vessels arriving from affected countries.</i></p>
DAHEJ/HAZIRA	<p>Vessels arriving from affected countries will be screened by the PHO / concerned authorities basis documents submitted in advance, by email and the PHO will declared the vessel as either "Suspected" or "Healthy" - according to their screening report. Healthy vessels will be given necessary clearance, for berthing & to commence cargo operations. With regard to suspected vessels - authorities will board the vessel for further screening / Clearance. If any CREW is found affected or having symptoms of CoVID-19 - permission for berthing / port operation will be subject to PHO discretion.</p> <p><i>*Currently Port is not following 14 days quarantine period at anchorage; for vessels arriving from affected countries.</i></p>
MUMBAI	<p>All vessels arriving from any foreign ports (Irrespective of affected countries) - are required to produce mandatory 'Maritime Health Declaration' by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 HRS, prior arrival to Port. After receipt of all the documents PHO will advise for berthing clearance or whether the ships need any Screening on berthing. By Pre Arrival Screening the ships will be categorized to Healthy & Suspect Ships. Healthy ships will undergo routine Port Operations.</p> <p>The newly embarked crew or any crew at berth when develops fever or respiratory symptoms, will be isolated and given PPE immediately and shall intimate Port Control and Agent to alert PHO,CMO. In case PHO finds any COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard then vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage till further clearance from PHO.</p> <p><i>*Currently Port is not following 14 days quarantine period at anchorage for vessels arriving from affected countries.</i></p>
JAIGAD	<p><i>*All vessels arriving from affected countries (CHINA, HONG KONG, MACAU, JAPAN, SOUTH KOREA, INDONESIA, THAILAND, VIETNAM, MALAYSIA, SINGAPORE, ITALY, IRAN, FRANCE, GERMANY & SPAIN) will be quarantined (Mandatory) for 14 days at anchorage.</i></p> <p>During their stay at anchorage, health of all the crew members would be monitored on a day to day basis. Agent to send temperature report of the crew members on a daily basis. Post completion of time period 14 days from the last port of departure, vessel will be required to submit Free-Pratique from Ratnagiri PHO - for acceptance at berth.</p>
MORMUGAO	<p><i>*Vessels arriving from affected countries (CHINA, HONG KONG, MACAU, JAPAN, SOUTH KOREA, INDONESIA, THAILAND, VIETNAM, MALAYSIA, SINGAPORE, ITALY, IRAN, FRANCE, GERMANY & SPAIN) will be quarantined for 14 days at anchorage. Once the quarantine period is over PHO will ask for the new health declaration from Master on the health condition and board as usual for clearance purpose.</i></p> <p>All Vessels arriving from foreign ports (other than listed in affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 hrs prior arrival to Port. The declaration will be scrutinized by PHO and if all crew found to be healthy then vessel will be allowed for berthing Upon PHO clearance. In case PHO finds any</p>

	COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard then vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage till further clearance from PHO.
MANGALORE	<p>All vessels arriving from any foreign port (Irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew (twice a day if arriving from affected countries) prior arrival to Port. The declaration will be scrutinized by PHO and if all crew found to be healthy then vessel will be allowed for berthing Upon PHO clearance. In case PHO finds COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard then vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage till further clearance from PHO.</p> <p>*Currently Port is not following 14 days quarantine period at anchorage for vessels arriving from affected countries.</p>
COCHIN	<p>There is no specific restriction for Vessels coming from CHINA or other restricted countries. All vessels are screened as per the guidelines issued and necessary submission of all mandatory documents. In case PHO find COVID-19 symptoms for crew while screening onboard then vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage till further clearance from PHO.</p>

***E/Coast Indian Ports:**

PORTS	QUARANTINE PROCEDURES
KOLKATA / HALDIA	<p>The CREW of all ships berthing at Kolkata, Haldia are subjected to mandatory thermal screening immediately on arrival. If a vessel is coming directly from a CHINESE Port; the same will be compulsorily quarantined for 14 days and on completion of 14 days waiting at Sagar Anchorage – she will be allowed to berth only after satisfactory thermal screening at Anchorage of all CREW onboard.</p> <p>Until now, no vessel have been affected due to this as most of the vessels arriving would have already crossed 14 days in transit. Also, Haldia being 2nd discharge port for bulk cargoes, in India, the vessel would have definitely crossed the required number of quarantine days, by then.</p>
PARADIP	<p>All vessels arriving from any foreign port (Irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 hrs prior arrival to Port and twice daily while at port till departure. The declaration will be scrutinized by PHO and if all crew found to be healthy then vessel will be allowed for berthing Upon PHO clearance. In case PHO finds any COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard then vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage till further clearance from PHO.</p> <p>Though there is no circular issued if vessel arrived from affected countries then the Limited free Pratique is granted and PHO / CMO team to board the vessel upon berthing and after screening the vessel is granted free Pratique and allowed to sail. The berthing is also accorded only upon receipt of clearance from the PHO office basis the declaration submitted by Master. If all crew are healthy and no any sick person on board the vessels berthing is accorded. If all O.K., there is currently no restriction like 14 days waiting.</p>
GOPALPUR	<p>All vessels arriving from any foreign port (Irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 hrs prior arrival to Port. The declaration will be scrutinized by PHO and if all crew found to be healthy then vessel will be allowed for berthing Upon PHO clearance. In case PHO / Port Marine department finds any COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard then vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage till further clearance from</p>

	PHO. If all O.K., there is currently no restriction like 14 days waiting. Master to submit the Maritime declaration of health as per Port format as attached / circulated by port.
DHAMRA	All vessels arriving from any foreign port (Irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 hrs prior arrival to Port. The declaration will be scrutinized by PHO and if all crew found to be healthy then vessel will be allowed for berthing Upon PHO clearance. In case PHO finds any COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard then vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage till further clearance from PHO. If all O.K., there is currently no restriction like 14 days waiting.
VIZAG	All vessels arriving from any foreign port (Irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 hrs prior arrival to Port. The declaration will be scrutinized by PHO and if all crew found to be healthy then vessel will be allowed for berthing Upon PHO clearance. In case PHO finds any COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard then vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage till further clearance from PHO. If all O.K., there is currently no restriction like 14 days waiting.
KAKINADA	All vessels arriving from any foreign port (Irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 hrs prior arrival to Port. The declaration will be scrutinized by PHO and if all crew found to be healthy then vessel will be allowed for berthing Upon PHO clearance. In case PHO finds any COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard then vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage till further clearance from PHO. If all O.K., there is currently no restriction like 14 days waiting.
KRISHNAPATNAM	All vessels arriving from any foreign port (Irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 hrs prior arrival to Port. The declaration will be scrutinized by PHO and if all crew found to be healthy then vessel will be allowed for berthing Upon PHO clearance. In case PHO finds any COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard then vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage till further clearance from PHO. If all O.K., there is currently no restriction like 14 days waiting.
CHENNAI/ ENNORE/ KARAIKAL/ KATTUPALLI	<p>The Crew/ Passengers of all vessels are subjected to mandatory thermal screening by PHO, Chennai and allowed for berthing on arrival.</p> <p>On a case to case basis; vessels coming from CHINA have to wait at Outer Anchorage for completion of 14 days Quarantine - based on the risk analysis, done – they will be thoroughly screened and will be allowed, for berthing. It is at the sole discretion of local PHO to grant necessary clearance to berth or not.</p>
TUTICORIN	All vessels arriving from any foreign port (Irrespective of affected countries) are required to produce health declaration by Master and the daily temperature declaration of all crew 72/48/24 hrs prior arrival to Port. The declaration will be scrutinized by PHO and if all crew found to be healthy then vessel will be allowed for berthing Upon PHO clearance. In case PHO finds any COVID-19 symptoms for a crew while screening onboard then vessel will be immediately shifted to anchorage till further clearance from PHO. If all O.K., there is currently no restriction like 14 days waiting.
